## Whitman's James Major Lends Support to Brownfields Project in Woodbridge

Mayor of Woodbridge Township John E. McCormac, along with the El Paso Corporation, the Brownfields Development Area Steering Committee, the Woodbridge Redevelopment Agency and a public/private partnership recently announced the start-up of remediation and restoration of the former Nuodex property in Woodbridge Township. The 160+ acre former chemical manufacturing site is the largest segment of the Brownfield Development Area (BDA) located in the Keasbey Redevelopment Zone. The area received its BDA designation by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) in 2009, which allowed the Township to move forward with coordinating site remediation. Redevelopment activities include the restoration of more than 100 acres of environmental wetlands, featuring public access to an environmental river walk, viewing platforms, ecological information, and access to the Raritan River for recreational activities such as boating and fishing.

**Whitman Vice President James Major**, a Councilman and Redevelopment Agency Commissioner in Woodbridge Township, spoke at the ground-breaking ceremony at the BDA site, supporting the town's redevelopment efforts. Major said, "this project is a win-win public/private partnership that will remediate over 160 acres of brownfields, create viable business redevelopment in the future, and provide a waterfront park for the community." The township Redevelopment Agency is currently in discussion to locate a state-of-the-art energy complex in the industrial section of the site. In addition to new tax rates, Woodbridge anticipates new employment opportunities when the projects are complete.

**Whitman Senior Vice President Michael Sylvester**, recognized on both National and State levels as an expert in Brownfields, also attended the ceremony and toured the facility. Whitman is a leader in Brownfield redevelopment as well as mechanical, electrical, civil and structural engineering.
