

## Storage Tank Management Services

### Overview

Historically, underground and above ground storage tanks (USTs and ASTs) have been used to store fuel oil to heat buildings, or to power emergency generators or boilers. Over time however, many these tanks have corroded and leaked their contents, resulting in contamination of surrounding soil and groundwater, and significantly impacting the value of properties.

Understanding and applying the regulatory requirements involved in the investigation and closure of these storage tank systems can prove complicated. If you are a tank owner or a property buyer, you may find yourself asking these questions:

- *What is the difference between a regulated and an unregulated storage tank?*
- *What do I do if I find an underground storage tank during site development?*
- *What do I do if I've confirmed a release from a UST?*
- *What happens if the soil and ground water results are below the NJDEP Standards?*
- *What happens if the soil and ground water results are above the NJDEP Standards?*
